Replacement type heifers weighing from 500#-700# sold on a very strong market this week as well. The packer market was softer again as plants are still backed up with cows. Next week we have 150+ head of calves coming off 4-5 ranches. Most, but not all, of these calves will be weaned and will weigh from 400# - 800#. There will be several good replacement type heifers amongst these calves. We expect another strong market next week with the renewed interest in calves after our recent rains.
