COMMENTS:

Cattle sold well today on an active market with strong demand. The calf market was mostly steady to \$5 higher and packer cows/bulls also advanced another \$5 this week. The futures market made strong advances to start the week off from signs of stronger demand and smaller show lists of fat cattle in the feed yards. Next week we have about 150 head of weaned calves coming in off 3 ranches. If you have some weaned calves ready to sell, next Tuesday looks to be a good time to market them. It may be a good time to cull any older cows/bulls with the advances the packer market has made over the last 3 weeks.
