COMMENTS:

The packers and feedlots have been playing the Bulls vs. the Bears game for several weeks now and the feeders have been coming out on top week after week. However, the live cattle contracts have refused to match current cash prices. Since the 1st of March, the April live cattle board has ranged from \$115-\$118 while the cash market has been at least \$10 higher. With feed yards filling up, some are expecting the market to break, but fundamentally, the market remains strong with excellent beef demand, promising exports and higher boxed beef prices. Today's market was steady to \$2 higher with good demand from the buyers. Short term, this market looks to remain steady as we approach Spring, but could give way to the Bearish side of the market if the packers ever gain any traction.
