Prices held again this week as all calves/yearlings sold on an active, steady market. The Cattle on Feed Report that came out showed no real surprises and has had a minimal effect on the futures and/or cash market. Carcass weights on cattle coming out of the nation's feed yards have continued to decrease allowing the overall tonnage of beef to be smaller than what it would have been in years past. At some point in the near future, we will see an influx of fat cattle ready for slaughter from the heavy replacements that went into the feed yards earlier this year. By having lighter carcass weights and an increased beef demand as the weather warms up, we can hope to continue to have a steady market.
