*Since last week the futures market has been very volatile. After falling off midweek, it was up the limit Friday only to start off Monday and Tuesday by losing what it had gained Friday. The progress with our trade relationship with China doesn't appear to be strong enough to sustain our current price level, at least not until they get a deal worked out going forward. While packer cows and bulls sold on a steady market today, the calves and yearlings were about \$5 off from what we saw last week. We do have a couple of herd sell outs that we will be marketing in the next couple weeks.
