Packers have been active trying to fill orders as we approach Memorial Day which is seasonally beef's biggest sales week of the year. Last week's cattle sales on fat calves coming out of the feedlot were from \$143-\$147, nearly \$20 higher than we were three weeks ago. With that being said, the futures market has run out of momentum, at least until they see where calves are traded this week. Today's market was strong and steady as we had several really good sets of yearlings to offer. Next week we are looking to have about 30 Angus cows off one ranch to market.
