## COMMENTS:

Stocker cows and packer cows/bulls sold steady today while the calf market was \$5-\$10 softer in most cases. Hot and dry weather is here which hurts the performance of calves/yearlings, especially calves coming straight off of cows. As it does almost every year, the summer market becomes a little more stagnant resulting in cheaper prices for the cow/calf operations needing to market calves this time of year. To complicate matters worse, the futures board has dropped off hard in the last couple of weeks which has found its way down to the cash market. It seems the main reason for the drop in the futures market is stemming from the news of JBS putting all of their feed lots up for sale after more of the Bautista Brothers' scandal comes to light. JBS is a huge corporation worldwide and the sooner this gets cleared up the better for the cattle industry. Keep in mind we will be closed for our July 3rd & July 4th sales, so next Tuesday will be the last cattle sale before the holiday.
